Dear Friends,

As you are reading this, The Moonlight has so far this summer produced two musicals and nine concerts as part of our first-ever Moonlight Summer Jam. In our 41 years of existence, we have never had a full calendar of events as we do this summer. One primary reason for this calendar growth is due to the visionary work of Colleen Kollar Smith, our Executive Producer. We bid Colleen a heartfelt goodbye on July 15. In August, she takes the next step in her career. Collen has accepted an executive position with the University of California, San Diego, where she will oversee the university's presenting program, including their new Epstein Family Amphitheatre, a 2000-plus capacity venue set to open this fall.

When Colleen joined the City of Vista initially as Managing Director on February 8, 2017, she began to articulate her

vision for transformative growth right out of the gate. Among her many responsibilities, she inherited the programming of our presenting program and set about growing it. Since then, Colleen has invited to perform at The Moonlight the likes of the San Diego Symphony, Abba-Mania, Classic Albums Live, John Waite, Queen Nation, and many other artists. The result has been a significant increase in attendance and an excitement in programming that has never been as palpable.

Colleen has been lauded for being a fantastic partner and collaborator with the Moonlight Cultural Foundation. She has strengthened the partnership between the City and the Foundation to new heights. She has continually supported efforts to cultivate and steward donors through the giving process, forged partnerships with community organizations, and helped establish the Foundation's Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion committee.

With Moonlight Youth Theatre, Colleen has been a champion of that program by supporting its artistic and educational goals by working directly with its young participants as a choreographer on productions.

During the difficult times of the pandemic in 2020, Colleen seized the opportunity to create a memorable event during the holidays, Jingle Terrace Park. This drive-thru light holiday experience in Brengle Terrace Park was fully funded by sponsors that Colleen secured. Jingle Terrace Park provided thousands of people the opportunity to leave their homes during the pandemic so they could experience a safe and free community event. This gave visitors hope when it was needed most. Jingle Terrace Park continues to be held during the holiday season.

On behalf of The Moonlight staff, the City of Vista, and the Moonlight Cultural Foundation, we send our heartfelt good wishes to Colleen. We are confident that she will continue to soar and have the same transformational effect at the University of California, San Diego, as she had here.

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
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
